Obligations of the Purchaser and the Seller upon signing this Vehicle Sale and Purchase Contract:

- The **Seller** shall confirm that the vehicle being sold is owned by him, that no third parties have any rights or claims to the vehicle being sold, that the vehicle has not been seized, that it is not the subject of any legal dispute, and that the right to dispose of it has not been revoked or restricted. The identification number and other details of the vehicle being transferred correspond to the details specified in its registration document.
- The **Purchaser** and the **Seller**, in accordance with Article 20(1) of the Republic of Lithuania Law on Road Traffic Safety, shall be obliged to declare to REGITRA the data on the acquired or transferred ownership of the vehicle, i.e. the **Purchaser** shall within 5 working days from the date of acquisition of ownership, and the **Seller** shall within 5 working days from the date of the **Purchaser's** declaration of the data on the acquired ownership.
- The **Seller** and the **Purchaser** shall certify that they are aware that only those vehicles whose owner has declared data on the ownership of the registered vehicle to the administrator of the Road Transport Vehicle Register of the Republic of Lithuania (REGITRA) in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 20 of the Law on Road Traffic Safety of the Republic of Lithuania.
- The **Purchaser** shall confirm that, prior to concluding this contract, they have assessed the mileage (odometer data) of the vehicle, as well as the condition of the vehicle and its individual parts, and have no claims against the **Seller** in this regard.
